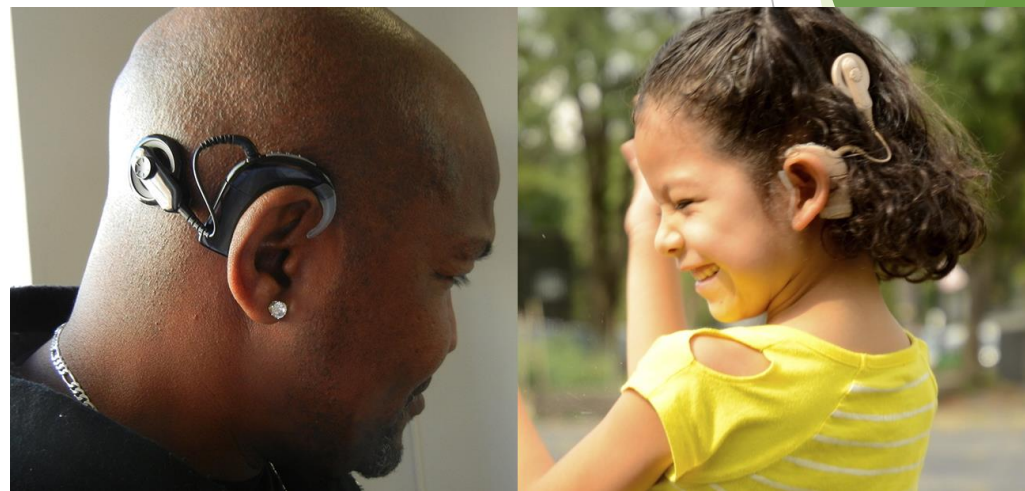
"Sometimes the loudest things in the world are the things you can't hear at all."

Think about these two quotes and what they mean, you can talk about them with an adult.



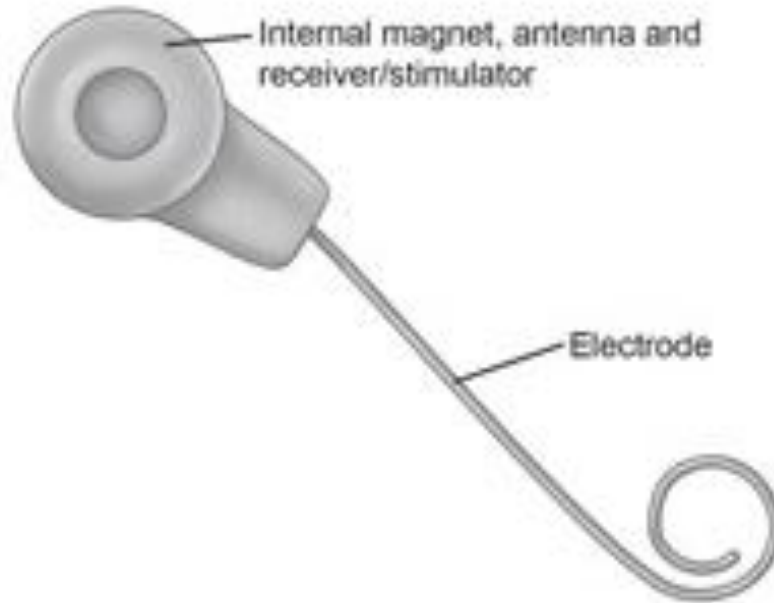
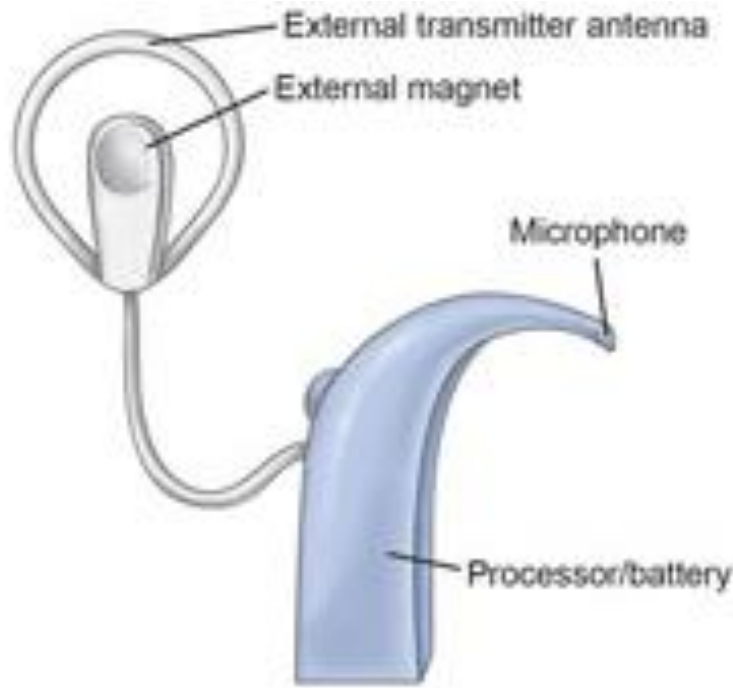
Hearing Aids and Cochlear Implants



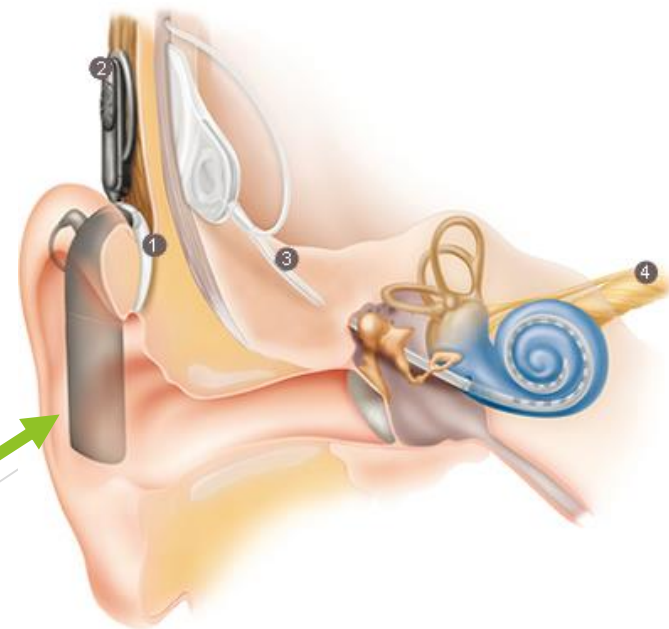
Cochlear Implants

Read it and empathise with your deaf friends.

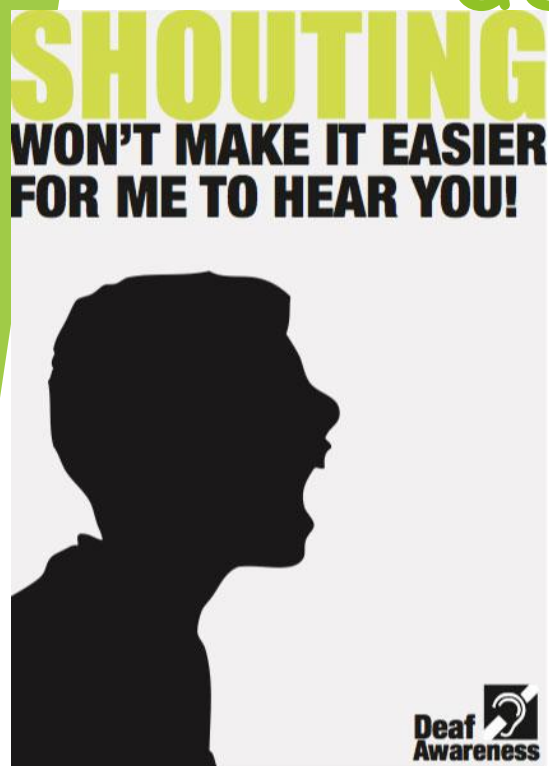


Write down what you would say to your deaf friend who is about to have an operation to get a cochlear implant.
