Dear Parent/carers,

RE: PE kit for EYFS children

After half term, your child requires a PE kit in school for their Physical Education (PE) sessions. PE is a statutory part of the National curriculum.

Physical Education is an essential life skill, and all children are expected to take part. Sessions take place on a weekly basis.

For this session children are required to bring the following to school in a named PE bag:

- Green t-shirt with the school logo or a white t-shirt,
- Blue, black or grey tracksuit bottom,
- Black plimsolls or trainers.

You can purchase the kit from the school office. ALL items of uniform MUST be labelled with child's full name and class and provided in the labelled PE bag (available to buy from the office).

Learning to dress and undress and take responsibility for their clothes and for changing quickly is an important part of developing independence. Learning that we wear different clothes for different reasons is also important.
