## MESSAGES FOR PARENTS

**Reading and Library books:** As your child bring home reading books this week, we would like to remind you of the need for children to look after reading and library books.

Your role as parents is to ensure children respect and take care of their own and the property of others and take responsibility if losses or damage occurs. Children of all ages can be expected to do this.

After an extensive audit, as you know, we have discovered over £800 worth of books lost or not returned from home. This suggests some families are not taking adequate responsibility for school property. Schools have a very limited budget to spend on reading books and we will no longer tolerate this poor attitude from some children and families.

There will now be an immediate £5.00 charge for any book that is lost/ not returned within a week of its due return date. No books will be issued until a payment is received on ParentPay.

You may be interested to know local schools are now asking parents to supply stationary for children. School Governors will soon be making similar decisions here.

**Positive Parenting Workshop:** This term we are offering a series of workshops for parents, run by the Brent Council's Early Help & Family Support Service. These workshops offer support and advice on tricky parenting topics (see below). Each workshop runs from 9am – 11am. A crèche will be provided for those who require it (places in the crèche must be pre-booked). Look out for the fliers advertising the workshops.
