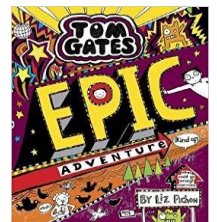
Your child's PE kit: Please remember to send your child with their full PE kit on the day's they have PE allocated. *Ms. Kantor*
