



HEADTEACHER'S MESSAGE

Dear parents/Carers,

Home learning: Are you doing it right?

Children's daily home learning is reading and self-quizzing. This strategy enables children to memorise key learning – which is then tested (memory retrieval)

Knowledge improves each time we have to find information from our memory – as knowledge improves we work faster and with more accuracy.

How to do self-quizzing:

- Look , then say (EACH LETTER OR NUMBER) , then cover **BEFORE** writing the word or number equation. Children then CHECK to see if they are correct.
- By the end of the week accuracy should be 100% in tests
- Where children are just copying – then tests are showing this. They will not be improving their knowledge if they copy.

Remember to help your child achieve their best by showing them how to COVER the words and equations whilst writing.

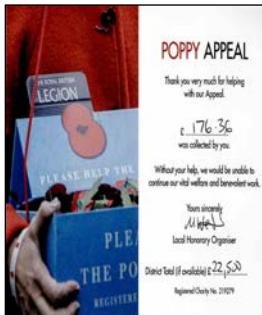
