Written Statement of Behaviour Principles



Every pupil understands that they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others.

They know that at school their responsibility is to be Ready, Respectful and Safe.

These three simple words run hand in hand with our values of Empathy, Agility and Hard work.

Our values and policies are in place so that

- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the Motivation and Behaviour policy
- The Motivation and Behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff
- The exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions
- Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
- We use visible consistencies through the school so all children work within clearly understood boundaries and care
- Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances. This is emphasised through the staff code of conduct, the home –school agreement and our policy on managing violence and aggression in the work place.
