Children will:

- develop use of subordinating conjunctions

Spelling

Art

Tree silhouette

Children will:

- create a silhouette tree image to learn about light and dark
- look at the Joranka Yaretz’s use of tree silhouettes
- study trees using pencil and graphite sticks
- use colour blends with oil pastels to create a light background
- discuss what colours create a light background and what colours blend together

French

Children will:

- learn about family members
- talk about masculine and feminine nouns and adjectives – agreement
- describe family relations and learn the names for pets
