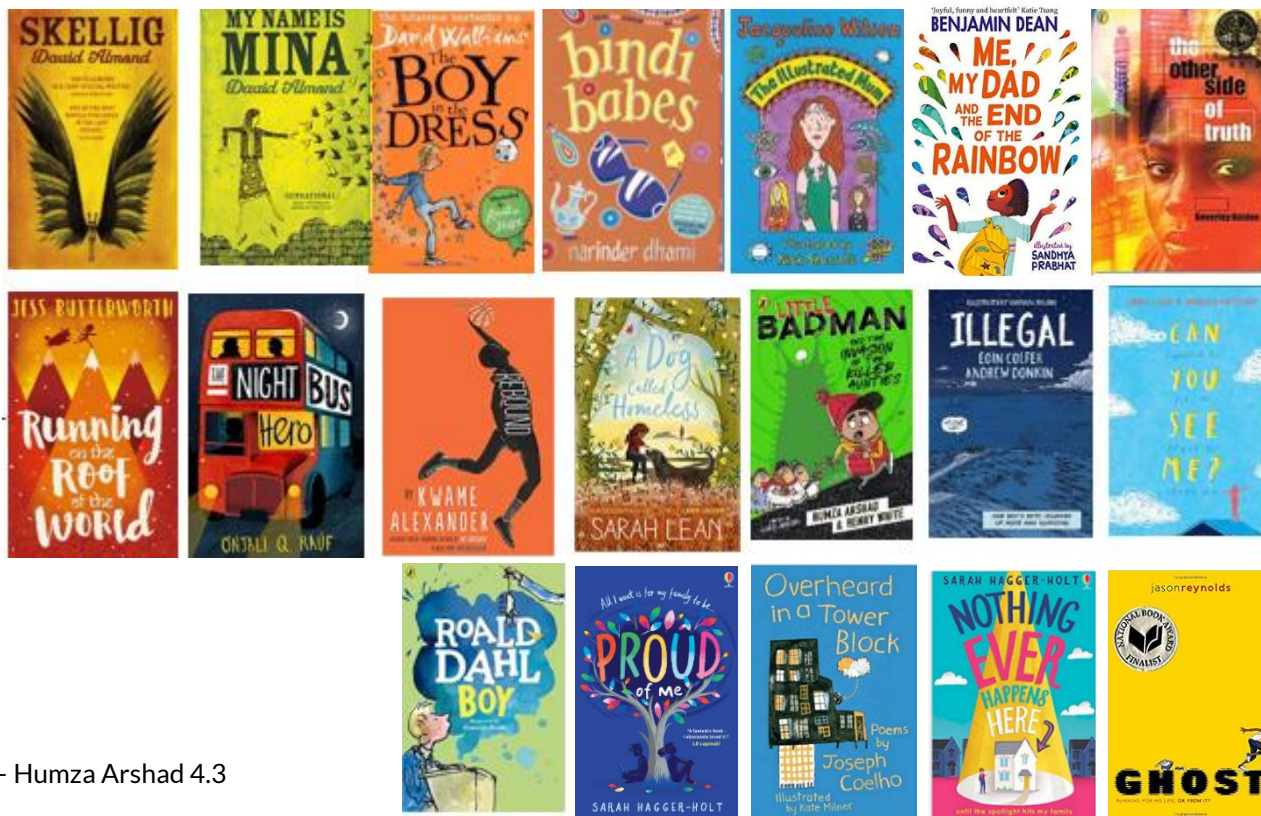


## WHEN YOU HAVE READ A BOOK, TICK THE BOX – HOW MANY HAVE YOU READ?

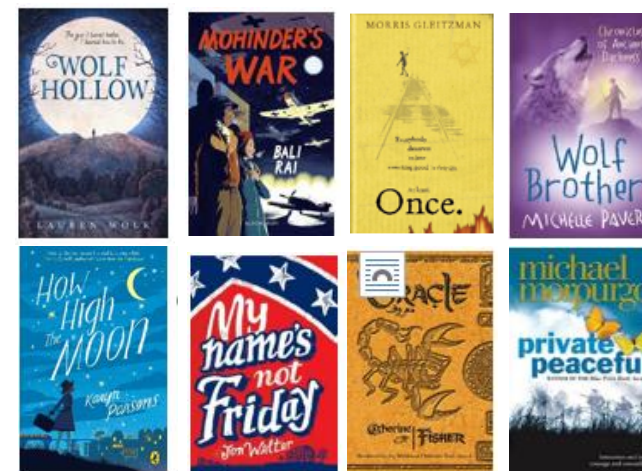
## **SCIENCE FICTION:** including other and future worlds, time travel, AI, technology, environment
